



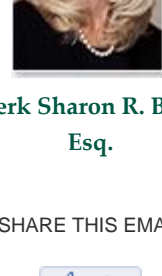

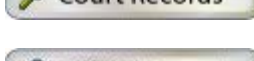
Clerk Bock Sworn in as President-Elect of Florida Court Clerks & Comptrollers

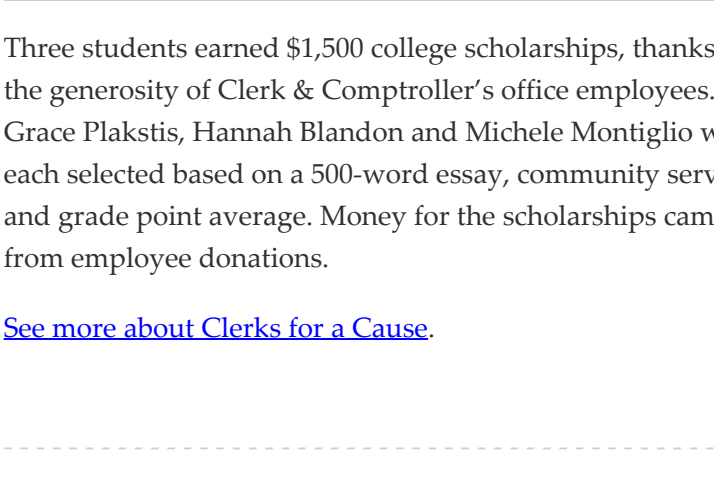

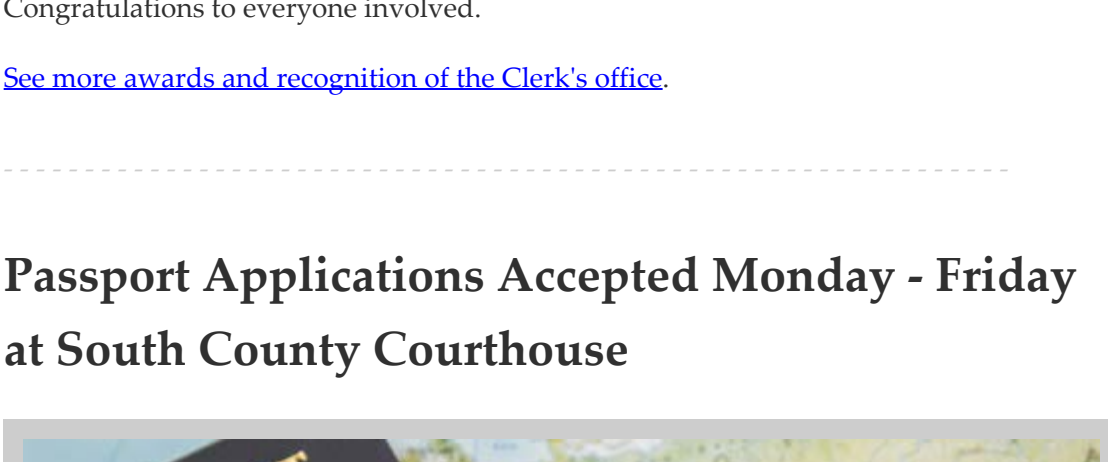
