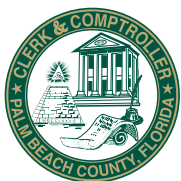

DOMESTIC PARTNERSHIP FAQs

DO I QUALIFY?

Domestic Partners must be adults who are not married or registered in another domestic partnership. Relatives do not qualify. Domestic partners must live together and consider each other as a member of their immediate family. For a full list of qualifications, please visit www.mypalmbeachclerk.com.

WHAT BENEFITS ARE INCLUDED?

- Health care visitations & decisions
- Funeral/burial decisions
- Notification of family members
- Pre-need guardian designation for incapacitated partners
- Visitation rights at county juvenile detention & correctional facilities

HOW DO I REGISTER?

Download a Domestic Partnership Declaration form at www.mypalmbeachclerk.com or visit any Clerk's office location.

Once you complete the application, bring it to the Clerk's office and sign it in front of a deputy clerk. You may also submit it by mail after having it notarized. The form must be submitted with proof of mutual residency and joint financial responsibility. The Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners established the Domestic Partner Registry by Ordinance 2006-002.
